Imam Nafis Bhayat was born in India and moved to England in his early childhood. His quest for Islamic knowledge began at a very young age. He completed the memorization of the Quran at the tender age of 13. Thereafter, he continued his Islamic studies at Darul Uloom Bury, UK, for the next six years in the field of Tafseer, Hadeeth, Fiqh, Aqaid and the Arabic language.

Since graduating with a degree in Islamic theology in 1992, Imam Nafis has been serving as the head imam and director of religious services at the Islamic propagation centre of Ontario, also known as Jame Masjid Mississauga, Canada, until this present day. His weekly Tafseerul Quran classes attracts the attendance of over 200 participants.

Imam Nafis is an executive member of the Canadian council of Imams, Canadian Council of Muslim Theologians, Shariah advisor to UM financial and Ontario registered minister of religion & licensed marriage officer.

He is frequently invited to deliver khutbahs at various masajids and religious institutions.
